Definitions

Clutter

- Anything in life that weighs us down, distracts us from our purpose, or robs us of mental or spiritual health
- A collection of things lying around in an untidy mess
- A confused or disordered state or collection
- Chaos; jumble; disorder

Toxic

Causing unpleasant feelings; harmful or malicious; deadly; noxious

Antidote

A medicine or other remedy for counteracting the effects of poison or disease

Something that prevents or counteracts injurious or unwanted effects

Clear clutter from your External Environment.

Your external environment is anywhere you spend your time:

- Home
- Job
- Church (Ideally, your church is not a toxic environment. Church should help you detox.)
- Wherever you participate in leisure or recreational activities

The clutter in your external environment is not entirely within your control.

Toxic People

- May have **toxic attitudes** (negativity: on a good day, the glass is half empty; on a bad day, they don't see any glass at all.)
- May use **toxic language** (profanity)
- May indulge in **toxic behavior** (gossip)

Toxic Family members

- Always need your help but rarely available to help.
- You cannot choose your family members, but you can set boundaries and you can set the atmosphere in your home.

Toxic Friends

- Always need your help but rarely available to help.
- Are your friends truly friends?

Toxic Co-workers

- You are required to work with them; but you are not required to socialize with them.
- Set boundaries. Make it clear that profanity is unacceptable.
